DANIEL VIGNES PRIZE 2ND EDITION

The International Association for the Law of the Sea (AssIDMer) confers, every two years, during its Ordinary Meeting, a prize for the best article published in a journal or a collective work, to disseminate knowledge of the international law of the sea. Articles can be written in English, Spanish, French, Italian, and Portuguese.

With the sole exception of members and former members of the Board of the Association, the competition is open to everyone under the age of 40 by the deadline for sending the article.

Applications must be submitted by mail to the Secretary General of the International Association of Law of the Sea, Prof. Nathalie Ros (<u>n.ros@assidmer.net</u>), before 15 April 2018 (deadline for applications). The Secretary-General will inform the applicants of the admissibility of their candidature and communicate the e-mail addresses of the members of the jury awarding the prize to send their articles.

The amount of the prize is 700 Euros. The winners will automatically become members of the Association. The fee is part of the amount of the prize.

The prize will be officially awarded during the VII Ordinary Meeting of the Association in 2018.
